BSMRAAU INKS CONTRACT FOR MASTER PLAN OF LALMONIRHAT CAMPUS

Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman Aviation and Aerospace University (BSMRAAU) – country’s first public university for aviation and aerospace studies has inked a contract for “consultancy service for feasibility study, master plan and DPP preparation for BSMRAAU” on 17 February 2022 at its Dhaka campus. According to the contract, the lead firm Vitti Sthapati Brindo Limited and Dev Consultants Limited along with their foreign counterpart Yasui Architects and Engineers Inc, Japan is expected to complete the job by end of this year to facilitate functioning of the University from its Lalmonirhat campus. The signing ceremony was attended by the Vice Chancellor, Air Vice Marshal Muhammad Nazrul Islam and other high officials of the University.



Established in 2019 through the Act number 5 of the Parliament, BSMRAAU is mandated to be hub of nation’s aviation and aerospace studies and research activities. The project is aligned with government’s aspiration to transform Bangladesh into a knowledge-based society and aviation hub by 2041, and ensure equitable access to quality education to the people of north-eastern region of the country. According to the University’s proposed Strategic Road Map-2041, BSMRAAU aspires to become

a leading international university in the field of aviation, space and technological studies through excellence. Apart from its ongoing aviation and aerospace-related programmes, BSMRAAU will soon offer post-graduate programmes on space system engineering, satellite communication engineering and autonomous system design.

Mentionable that 27 lead firms along with their national and international partners contested through the government prescribed process to provide consultancy services of this unique project. Out of them five firms were shortlisted and Vitti Sthapati Brindo Limited (Lead firm) and Dev Consultants Limited along with his foreign counterpart Yasui Architects and Engineers Inc, Japan was selected as consultant firm.

Speaking in the occasion, the Vice Chancellor, reiterated the importance of completing the project in time. He stressed that the completion of the project will enable BSMRAAU to operate with full potentials to realise it mission of transforming people into aviation, apace and technological professional and enthusiast by providing world class education.
